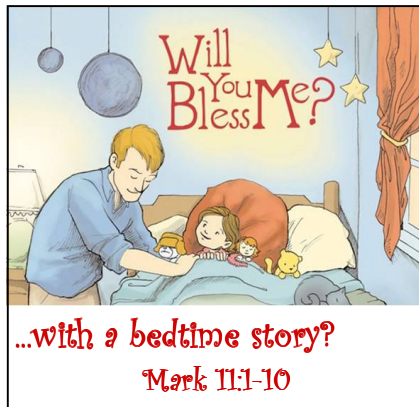
Hello Parents,

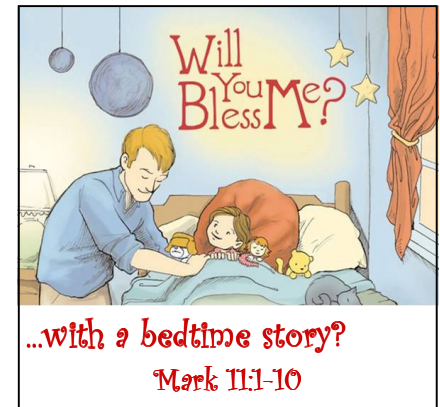
