***“Shrub on Fire:
Part 2”***

Hello Parents,

Today was our fourth lesson from our series, “Moses Is Born”. We learned that Moses asks God who to say has sent him when the Israelites ask. God tells him His name is ‘I am who I am’. He tells Moses to say “I am” has sent you. God also tells Moses to say the Lord, the God of their fathers, has sent him. God tells Moses to gather the elders of Israel together and he is to tell the elders that the God of their fathers appeared to him and has seen what is happening in Egypt. He also tells Moses to say that God will bring them out of their misery, to a land flowing in milk and honey. God tells Moses that they will listen to him. He also tells Moses that he and the elders should ask the king of Egypt to let them go to the desert for three days to offer sacrifices to God. He tells Moses that he will strike the Egyptians with signs and wonders until the King lets them go.
