All of these up and coming leaders are trained, mentored, and attend the annual Children's Ministry Orientation.

Plan to Protect

HOW WE PROTECT OUR KIDS AND VOLUNTEERS

Children are naturally trusting; they readily place their faith in adults who care for them. It is our responsibility as a church to protect that trust and to protect that faith.

- It is our commitment to provide protective care to all children and youth attending any programs sponsored by CLCC.
- Christian Life Community church subscribes to the Plan to Protect policy. The objective is to safeguard the children and youth of CLCC from abuse; protect CLCC staff and volunteer workers from potential allegations of sexual abuse; and limit the extent of legal risk and liability due to any such abuse.
- We screen all those who work with children and youth and require references and criminal record checks.
- Anyone found to have a criminal record involving children is not permitted to work with children or youth at CLCC.
- All of our children & youth workers sign a Ministry Covenant agreeing to comply with the church policy & guidelines.
- We train all of our staff, both paid & volunteer, to understand the nature of child abuse, to carry out our policies to prevent abuse, and to follow clearly defined reporting procedures for suspected incidents.
- We have a "two leader" rule which states that two people should be present during any children's activity.
- We follow the "six month" rule, which states that volunteers may work with children only after attending CLCC for six months or having reference checks, preferably from their previous church.
